Materials will be sold on "As is where is" and "No complaint" basis. No test certificate will be issued for the same.

The quantity indicated in the tender notice is only indicative and may vary upto (+/-) 30%. No claim of the tenderer on this account will be entertained.

2.0 INSTRUCTIONS TO THE TENDERER:

- 2.1 Tenders will be submitted in a sealed cover mentioning the relevant information like the name of the tenderer, tenderer no. lot no and tender opening date/time etc., on the cover in bold letters.
- 2.2 Tenders will be submitted in tender document issued by VSP wherever required or on the letterheads of the tenderers where no tender document is specified.

6.0 ISSUE OF ACCEPTANCE OF OFFER LETTER/CONCLUSION OF CONTRACT:

- 6.1 RINL, VSP shall issue Acceptance of Offer Letter to the successful tenderers which shall be conclusion of contract.
- 6.2 Such Acceptance of Offer letter shall be issued based on final rates quoted by the successful tenderer and accepted by VSP at the terms and conditions finally approved by VSP.

7.0 FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENT:

- 7.1 The successful tenderer should pay 100% of the value of the material including taxes and duties etc Offer Wise by RTGS/DD/Pay order/ Banker's Cheque drawn in favour of Rashtriya Ispat Nigam Limited, Payable at Visakhapatnam bearing the buyer's name on the face of the instrument along with the C/D form or any other Sales Tax Form as required. Otherwise full tax will be collected. The amount so collected will be adjusted against the invoices for the actual quantity delivered. The balance surplus deposits/advance will be refunded to the successful bidder after completion of the contract. - 7.2 The successful tenderer has to pay full amount as indicated in the Offer Letter issued for (pro-rated monthly contract quantity) or (offered quantity during the month) whichever is less within 7 days from the date of Offer Letter.
- 7.3 The tenderer has to pay full amount as per the Offer Letter for enabling VSP to issue Delivery Orders for the pro-rata monthly quantity.

8.0 DELIVERY OF MATERIAL:

- 8.1 Material will be delivered Ex-Plant, Visakhapatnam and purchaser has to arrange his own transport. The loading of the material into the vehicles will have to be carried out by the successful tenderer with his own labour arrangement or loader. Schedule of the vehicles to be placed shall be given by the Engineer-in Charge of respective works division.
- 8.2 Trucks will be placed at loading point as per the direction of VSP. Loading on trucks will be as per the instructions of VSP's representative at the place of loading. The tenderer will not be allowed to pick or choose the material. If any material other than subject tender material is found in the vehicles at time of the loading or weighment or at the time of issue of gate pass etc., suitable action will be taken as per the VSP rules and regulations and also considered the same as breach of contract under the tender.
- 8.3 The sale is on Ex-Plant basis. The risk and property of the material will pass on to the tenderer immediately after loading the materials into the vehicles.
- 8.4 Weight as per weighbridge of VSP will be final & no dispute will be entertained after the material leaves VSP premises.
- 8.5 If the tenderer intends to take the deliveries through his representative, he must authorize his representative by a letter of authorization giving name and details of such representative. The letter of authorization will be with the signature of the representative duly attested by the tenderer, who signed on the tender documents.

9.0 <u>DELIVERY SCHEDULE / EXTENSION</u>:

- 9.1 The tenderer should lift the quantity of lot quoted and accepted by the company within the stipulated period as per the special Terms & Conditions of the tender.
- 9.2 The successful tenderer shall deposit 100% advance payment Offer wise for lifting the material as per clause no:9.1 failure of which will be treated as breach of the contract and the company will forfeit the SD if lifting is not as per the satisfaction of Engineer-in-charge. Any losses due to such breach of contract on the part of the tenderer will also be recovered from any other amounts due to the bidder either under this tender or any other tender or contract.

10.0 TAXES & DUTIES:

12.0 GENERAL:

- 12.1 In case payments are not made or material not lifted after making part/full payment as per the conditions of the tender, the company will have the full right to dispose of the material of any manner as it deemed fit. The tenderer will have no claim on such materials. In such case the SD shall be forfeited. For any losses on account of such failure by the tenderer, RINL shall have right to recover the losses apart from other rights available to RINL under the law. - 12.2 If the fulfillment of the contract be rendered impossible by any executive or legislative act done by or on behalf of the Govt., the contract or any un-fulfillment part thereof will be cancelled.
- 12.3 The company at its entire discretion may terminate the contract without any notice to the tenderer in case there is any malafide intention noticed during lifting of materials from VSP. In the event of such termination of contract the SD will be forfeited.

SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR SPILLAGE LIME INSIDE CRMP

- 1. The material is to be collected by cleaning the floor areas of Kiln operator building (KOB), contact cooler platform, conveyor galleries, flux storage building area, ground floor area of lime plant etc. as shown by representative of Engineer-in-charge. The total quantity available for the year 2015-16 will be approx 1800 mt (+/- 30%). All the tenderers shall accept the change in quantity due to any reason as finalized by RINL, VSP.
- 2. It is required to engage 5 to 6 laborers daily for cleaning of the floor area, for loading and allied activities like collecting the materials from different locations, bagging etc. These loading and allied activities rests with the customer and the customer shall be responsible for fulfillment of all the statutory rules and regulations laid down by the Contract Labour Cell and Safety Engineering Dept of RINL which are subject to change from time to time.
- 3. Lime is generated by calcining Lime Stone. When the Lime comes into contact with water, exothermic reaction takes place, resulting in heat generation. So special care to be taken during transportation / handling of lime during rainy season.
- 4. Loading of the material into the trucks is to be arranged by the Tenderer only. In critical areas material has to be bagged and loaded and bag should be supplied by the tenderer. Trucks after loading must be covered with tarpaulin.
- 5. As the material is coming out of the cleaning of floor, the specification of the material may vary and also some foreign agglomerated material may be present.
- 6. All persons employed by the tenderer should undergo safety induction training conducted by VSP and they should work only in the designated area.. The movement in other areas is prohibited.
- 7. The tenderer should bring all tools and tackles required to carry out the job.
- 8. Safety appliances required for handling the lime fines and personal protection appliances should be provided by the tenderer.
- 9. Smoking is strictly prohibited in the working plant area.
- 10. The work area should be thoroughly cleared by the tenderer after completion of their job to the satisfaction of the Engineer-in-charge
- 11. Since the work involves deployment of Labour the tenderer should Produce copies of valid PF & ESI Registration certificates and a copy of valid Labour License wherever applicable along with their bid documents or shall submit the same to the concerned Engineer-in-charge before commencement of work. Insurance policy shall be taken covering all the workmen against injury, permanent disability, death etc., which shall be effective from the date of commencement of contract and cover the entire contract period, under Workmen's Compensation Act.
- 12. The tenderer is required to take third party liability insurance policy as per the Indian Workmen's Compensation Act, at his cost as per the satisfaction of Engineer-in-Charge.

- 13. The tenderer should ensure to follow all statutory requirements regarding workmen during the contract period to carry out the job as described above. All clearances from the competent authority may be obtained to follow the statutory requirements by the successful tenderer/contractor at his cost.
- 14. The tenderer shall suspend the work as per the instructions of Engineer-in-charge as and when directed.
- 15. The tenderer shall follow the safety regulations / instructions of VSP staff from time to time.
- 16. The tenderer shall ensure that while working at different floors, there is no damage to equipment or any other parts.
- 17. The tenderer shall follow the route specified from time to time by VSP for transportation of Lime.
- 18. The tenderer should provide a supervisor to oversee the operations and to coordinate with VSP staff.
- 19. The tenderer should work only between 6.00 AM to 6.00 PM..
- 20. Payment Terms: The successful tenderer has to pay full amount as indicated in the Offer Letter issued for (pro-rated monthly contract quantity) or (offered quantity during the month) whichever is less within 7 days from the date of Offer Letter.
- 21. Period of Contract: One Year from the date as mentioned in the LOI.
- 22. If the tenderer could not arrange labour for collecting the material and lift as per the directions of Engineer-in-charge, the work shall be got done by any other agency at the risk and cost of the tenderer.
- 23. The tenderer has to quote for a minimum quantity of 1080 mt and the job shall be awarded to two agencies to enable regular lifting.
- 24. For all purposes the Engineer-in-charge for the work shall be the representative from CRMP department.
- 25. As spillage material quantity generation is unpredictable, the available quantity may widely vary on day to day basis. The total quantity available for the year 2015-16 will be approx. 1800 mt +/- 30%. Minimum quantity to be lifted per month will be 105 MT or the quantity offered during the month whichever is less. The yearly quantity may also vary depending upon the SMS lime consumption.
- 26. **Lifting Terms:** Minimum quantities to be lifted per month will be (70% of the monthly pro-rated contract quantity) or (quantity offered during the month) whichever is less. If there is failure in 3 consecutive months, in fulfilling the minimum lifting criteria as mentioned above or failure to lift the (minimum 70% of total contract quantity) or (total offered quantity) whichever is less during the contract period, the full SD will be forfeited and contract shall be summarily closed. In case of failure in lifting minimum quantities is due to the lesser availability, order will not be cancelled and SD will not be forfeited. To this effect Engineer-in-charge has to certify the availability on monthly basis and also at the end of the year along with performance of the tenderers.
