Representatives of Omega hospital have also joined the service to screen patients for cancer. Patients who need further treatment will be taken to Gayatri Vidya Parishad hospital, vizag where also they will be given free treatment. Medical team from Visakha eye hospital assisted in conducting the ophthalmology related tests for the tribals. 345 villagers from Tajangi, Kittumula, Anjali sanivaram, Lambasinghi panchayath and adjoining areas were examined by the medical doctors team of Sri Sathya Sai Seva organisation, Visakha steel general hospital and others in the areas of general medicine, cardiology, pulmonology, paediatrics,

ophthalmology, dental, gynaecology, ortho, skin and other medical issues. The Villagers were also provided with free medicines, lunch. The camp was also assisted by the members of Visakha Eye Hospital, Gayatri Vidya Parishad Hospital, several sevadal (service volunteers) from ukkunagaram sri sai seva Samithi.
