Project Feedback:

The abandonment of elderly in Delhi/NCR has been increased, SHEOWS has been rescued and saved more than 400 destitute, helpless and abandoned elderly persons, currently there are 350 elderlies at Garhmukteshwar, UP and 105 elderlies in Delhi Centre. During these difficult times that the whole country is fighting from Covid, we are facing shortage of funds and individual in kind donations that we receive for our elderly living in the Ashram at Delhi and Garhmukteshwar. We expect more supports for long periods from RINL to save lives of elderly people.

- Improvement in day-to-day activities.

- Awareness about Alzheimer and dementia symptoms through school, college students and social media.
- Increased life span of elderly residents
- Mortality rate is decreased
